DAY 1 KOLKATA TO MUMBAI

Today we will meet and greet you at Kolkata International airport to Stockholm.



ARRIVE STOCKHOLM DAY 2

Arrive Stockholm. The capital of Sweden combines modern attractions with historic charm. This island ringed capital with cobbled streets and medieval buildings of the Old Town contrasting with the ultra-modern city center. After complete immigration transfer to Stockholm Pier for overnight Cruise.

DAY 3 ARRIVE TURKU/HELSINKI - ROVANIEMI

3 Arrive Turku Pier & transfer to Helsinki. Helsinki the capital city of Finland and a vibrant seaside city. Leave for a Guided tour of fascinating Capital Helsinki - highlighting major sightseeing places such as Senate Square - The Senate Square and its surroundings form a unique and cohesive example of Neoclassical architecture. The square is dominated by four buildings designed by Carl Ludvig Engé: Helsinki Cathedral, the Government Palace, the main building of the University of Helsinki and the National Library of Finland, Kamppi Chapel of Silence which is also known as the "Chapel of Silence" since it is intended to be a place to calm down and have a moment of silence in one of the busiest areas in Finland, Old Market Hall This traditional, 19th-century venue features shops & stalls offering unique Finnish specialties. Next board the scenic Santa Claus Express for your overnight journey to Rovaniemi.

ARRIVE ROVANIEMI - LEVI [OVERNIGHT IGLOO] DAY 4

Arrive Rovaniemi - official hometown of Santa Claus. Visit to the Arktikum - a museum, science centre, attraction and popular culture destination. The Exhibition lead guests on an adventure to Finnish Lapland and Arctic region. Enjoy a visit to Santa Claus Village where Santa himself spends most of the year meeting and greeting visitors from all over the world. Cheerful Postal Elves will post your greetings for you, and everything sent from here gets stamped by hand using the special postmark of the Santa Claus Post Office. After tour transfer to Levi for overnight stay at **IGLOO**.

DAY 5 LEVI - TROMSO

5 Morning after breakfast proceed towards Tromso. This Arctic City is the world's most Northern University Town & the largest city in the Nordic countries north of the Arctic Circle. Due to city's location right in middle of the planet's Northern Light's belt, Tromso offers the world's best chances of spotting the Northern Lights. In the late evening enjoy some of magical lights of Northern lights in the sky in different shades right from luminous green, often with a hint of pink along the edge, and occasionally with a deep violet center.

TROMSO DAY 6

Enjoy city tour which includes visit to Arctic Cathedral. The Cathedral of the Arctic Ocean," or simply the "Arctic Cathedral." Despite its nickname, it is a parish church and not, in fact, a cathedral as it is commonly called. Later visit Polar Museum - University museum with scientific, cultural & archaeological exhibits related to the Tromsø area. After dinner we will proceed to chase the northern lights.

DAY 7 TROMSO - NARVIK/KIRUNA

7 Morning after breakfast proceed to Narvik. Narvik, Situated between Tromsø and Lofoten, this unique destination combines the best of both worlds, dramatic fjord landscapes and classic Arctic inland adventures, all within a stable climate ideal for northern lights hunting, skiing and dogsledding. The port of Narvik proved to be strategically valuable in the early years of World War II and the town became a focal point of the Norwegian Campaign.

NARVIK/KIRUNA DAY 8

Morning after breakfast transfer to Kiruna city - The northern most Town of Sweden. On the way visit ice hotel. The interior is always between -5°C to -8°C, even when it gets up to -37°C outside. After that Enjoy an Orientation tour including Kiruna Church, City Hall etc. Later proceed to Railway station for overnight train to Stockholm.

DAY ARRIVE STOCKHOLM

9 Arrive Stockholm. Then we explore Stockholm city, we visit Magnificent Town Hall- the building of Municipal Council which houses offices, conference rooms, ceremonial halls, and luxury restaurants, Royal Palace- the official residence of His Majesty the King of Sweden, with over 600 rooms. Nobel Museum, where the annual Nobel Prize Award festivities take place every year etc. Dinner & overnight.

DAY STOCKHOLM - REYKJAVIK (By flight)

10 Morning after breakfast, transfer to Stockholm Airport for your flight to Reykjavik. Upon arrival proceed for an orientation tour of Reykjanes peninsula covering Gunnuhver - an impressive and colourful geothermal field of various mud pools and fumaroles in the southwest part of the Reykjanes Peninsula. It is tied to a fascinating legend of the region. Keilir, a volcanic mountain, southwest of Hafnarfjörður, and is the most recognizable landmark on the Reykjanes Peninsula. Katlahraun which is a lava field with beautiful and unusual rock formations. Next The Bridge Between the Continents - a bridge on the Reykjanes Peninsula that connects the North American and Eurasian tectonic plates. Later drive to the hotel then check in and overnight.

REYKJAVIK DAY

Morning after breakfast drive to Reynisfjara to visit the world-famous black-sand beach found on the **11** South Coast of Iceland, just beside the small fishing village of Vik. With its enormous basalt stacks, roaring Atlantic waves, and stunning panoramas, Reynisfjara is widely considered to be the most beautiful example of Iceland's black sand beaches. In 1991, National Geographic voted Reynisfjara as one of the Top 10 non-tropical beaches to visit on the planet. Later Proceed to Jökulsárlón Glacial Lagoon which has been the film location of many Hollywood movies. It is located at the end of an outlet glacier of the great Vatnajökull Glacier. Huge pieces of ice cave from the glacier and end up floating in the lagoon and out to sea. Return to hotel for overnight stay.

DAY REYKJAVIK 08th Mar 2025

12 After breakfast proceed to Reykjavik for the Golden Circle Route. Visit Thingvellir National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. A historic site and national park in Iceland, east of Reykjavik. Later move on to the iconic geothermal area around Geysir Hot Spring to see the incredible Geysers throw water steam up to 25 metres into the air. Visit the Gullfoss waterfall, located in the canyon of Olfusa river in southwest Iceland. Enjoy the energy and beauty of Gullfoss waterfall. This thundering waterfall can be experienced by the surrounding rocks or from the viewing platform above. Transfer to Hotel. Check in. Evening enjoy a unique experience of Hunting the northern lights from the ocean sailing away from the coastline of Reykjavik and seeing the aurora borealis out on the North-Atlantic ocean with beautiful mountains and the city in the background is something you won't forget. Overnight stay at Reykjavik.
