## DAY DEPART KOLKATA

Today we begin our journey by boarding our outbound flight to Japan. [<code>!!Meals On Board</code>]

### ARRIVE TOKYO DA

Today we arrive Tokyo - The Capital city of Japan. Upon arrival, all guests complete their airport formalities and proceed to hotel for check in. Overnight stay at Tokyo/Narita.

Today enjoy an orientation city tour of Tokyo, a bustling metropolis and the capital of Japan. Start your tour with a Rainbow Bridge and visit to Asakusa Sensoji Temple, one of Japan's most important Buddhist sites. Later we Drive by Odaiba, Japan National Diet Building & Tokyo Olympic Stadium. Next, we visit the Imperial Palace, the main residence of the Emperor of Japan followed by visit to Renkō-ji Temple which is a Buddhist temple in Tokyo, assumed to be the purported location of the ashes of Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose. Finally visit the Tokyo Tower, a symbol of Japan's post-war rebirth as a major economic power. Overnight stay at Tokyo.

TOKYO - HAKONE - MT FUJI - SHIZUOKA DAY

Morning proceed to Hakone. Hakone is a mountainous town known for its hot springs and views of the iconic volcano Mount Fuji. Next visit Owakudani Boiling Valley (subject to operation). Take a rope way ride into the volcanic zone of a number of steam vents and bubbling pools. Enjoy a cruise at Lake Ashi. Later Visit Mt Fuji's 5th Station, which lies about halfway up the mountain for more incredible views (in case of bad weather we will visit Fuji Visitor Center – a scientific pavilion which features the theme of nature, the history, culture of Mt Fuji). Overnight stay at Shizuoka.

# DAY SHIZUOKA - NAGOYA - HIROSHIMA

Morning Proceed to Nagoya - one of the nation's most important transportation hubs, historical centers and industrial powerhouses. Visit to Toyota Museum which showcases the worldwide history of automobiles and automobile culture. Later it's time for an exciting travel by Bullet train to Hiroshima from Nagoya station. Overnight stay at Hiroshima.

#### HIROSHIMA - OSAKA DAY

Today we visit Hiroshima, the city that was devastated by atomic bomb in World War II. Visit the Bomb dome, the symbol of Hiroshima and the only building to remain standing after the atomic explosion. See the Peace Memorial Park with its Museum. Next enjoy a ferry ride to Miyajima Island, to view the beautiful Itsukushima Shrine and the floating Torii – one of Japan's most scenic spots. Proceed to Osaka by bullet train. Overnight stay at Osaka.

### DAY OSAKA - KYOTO - OSAKA

Visit Fushimi Inari Shrine - the deity of a good harvest and success in business, Fushimi Inari Taisha is the head of all of Japan's Inari shrines. Later proceed to Kyoto, one of the most beautiful city of Japan. Visit the gardens of Golden Pavilion (Kinkakuji Temple), which houses sacred relics of Buddha. Visit Arashiyama bamboo grove - a mesmerizing grove of thousands of tall bamboo plants and one of the Kyoto's most photographed sights. We take a brief photostop at Togetsukyo bridge, a 400-year-old scenic bridge. Overnight at Osaka.

#### [!|Breakfast, Light/Packed Snacks & Dinner]

Osaka is known for its modern architecture. We visit Osaka Aquarium Kaiyukan, when it first opened, it was the largest public aquarium in the world. Drive by Osaka castle and later proceed to Nara – once the capital of Japan. Visit the Todai-ji temple - houses the largest Buddha statue in Japan followed by visit to Nara Deer Park - home to hundreds of freely roaming deer, which are considered as messengers of Gods and also been designated as National Treasure. In the evening stroll around Dotonbori district - a popular tourist and entertainment area characterized by its eccentric atmosphere and large illuminated signboards. Overnight at Osaka.
